**A BILL**

To direct the Postmaster General to conduct a study on retrofitting mail collection boxes with narrow mail slots to prevent theft of mail, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Keep Mail Safe Act”.

5 **SEC. 2. USPS REPORT ON RETROFITTING MAIL COLLEC-**  
6 **TION BOXES WITH NARROW MAIL SLOTS.**

7 Not later than 90 days after the date of the enact-  
8 ment of this Act, the Postmaster General shall submit a

1 report on retrofitting mail collection boxes to the Commit-  
2 tees on Appropriations and Oversight and Reform of the  
3 House of Representatives and the Committees on Appro-  
4 priations and Homeland Security and Governmental Af-  
5 fairs of the Senate. Such report shall include the following:

6       (1) A strategic plan, to be used by the United  
7 States Postal Service, to retrofit all mail collection  
8 boxes with narrow mail slots to prevent theft of the  
9 mail.

10       (2) The total estimated cost of carrying out  
11 such plan, the estimated length of time necessary to  
12 carry out such plan, and any other resources nec-  
13 essary to carry out such plan.

14       (3) With respect to any mail collection boxes  
15 that have been retrofitted on the date of the enact-  
16 ment of this Act, information on the location of such  
17 boxes, the security enhancements made to such  
18 boxes, and the reasons for retrofitting such boxes.
