## **JOINT RESOLUTION**

Proposing an amendment to the Constitution of the United States extending the right to vote to citizens sixteen years of age or older.

- 1 Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives
- 2 of the United States of America in Congress assembled
- 3 (two-thirds of each House concurring therein), That the fol-
- 4 lowing article is proposed as an amendment to the Con-
- 5 stitution of the United States, which shall be valid to all
- 6 intents and purposes as part of the Constitution when
- 7 ratified by the legislatures of three-fourths of the several

- 1 States within seven years after the date of its submission
- 2 for ratification:
- 3 "ARTICLE—
- 4 "Section 1. The twenty-sixth article of amendment
- 5 to the Constitution of the United States is hereby re-
- 6 pealed.
- 7 "Section 2. The right of citizens of the United
- 8 States, who are sixteen years of age or older, to vote shall
- 9 not be denied or abridged by the United States or by any
- 10 State on account of age.
- "Section 3. The Congress shall have power to en-
- 12 force this article by appropriate legislation.".
