Dear Director Decker:

We, members of the New York congressional delegation, are writing this letter on behalf of Mr. Xiuqing You, who is pending removal through Immigration and Customs Enforcement.

Mr. You is an immigrant from China who has resided in the United States for nearly two decades. His United States citizen wife, Ms. Yu Mei Chen, filed a family-based petition on his behalf that was approved by U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Services (USCIS). Mr. You was detained when he appeared for his scheduled adjustment of status interview with USCIS on Wednesday, May 23, 2018.

Mr. You and his wife have two United States citizen children, ages four and six, who are distraught by his absence. We have been advised that Mr. You does not have a criminal record and has put all his energy into supporting his young family. His removal would be cruel, and financial and emotional hardships would fester if he is no longer to remain in the United States.

Mr. You's friends and family request your office's favorable exercise of discretion so that he may remain here at home with his family and continue to work to support them. We would appreciate your review of this matter as well as your full and fair consideration consistent with applicable United States rules and regulations.
