## 2020 CORONAVIRUS REBATE

### WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

Those who have a Social Security number for themselves and qualifying children are eligible to receive rebates.

### HOW WILL I GET MY REBATE?

The Internal Revenue Service (IRS) will work to deliver automatic advance payments through electronic deposit or physical check. Payment processing will be based on information from 2018 and 2019 federal income tax returns. If the IRS does not have your current banking information, you can submit this through the IRS "Get My Payment" app [here](#).

### WHAT IF I DON'T FILE TAXES?

Those who typically do not file taxes can enter their payment information on the IRS website [here](#).

### WHAT IF I AM A SOCIAL SECURITY RECIPIENT?

You will receive your rebate automatically. Please contact the [IRS](#) for additional details.

### HOW MUCH WILL I GET?

The full rebate depends on the size of your family. Payments amounts are \$1,200 per adult and \$500 per qualifying child under 17. This equates to \$2,400 for joint filers. Rebate payments are reduced by \$5 for every \$100 to the extent the taxpayer's income exceeds \$150,000 for a joint filer, \$112,500 for a head of household filer, and \$75,000 for anyone else (including single filers).

### WILL THIS IMPACT MY OTHER BENEFITS?

No. This rebate is considered a tax refund and is not counted toward eligibility for federal programs.

### WILL MY REBATE BE TAXED?

No, the rebate is treated like other refundable tax credits, such as the child tax credit and earned income tax credit, and not considered income.
